ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Age Eligibility

- Infants and toddlers (Early Head Start) – Birth to 3 years old
- Preschoolers (Head Start) – 3 or 4 years old by 9/1

Income Eligibility

Children from low-income families are eligible for participation if their families' incomes are below the federal poverty line (see Federal Income Guidelines below), or if their families are receiving Public Assistance from TANF (CalWorks), Supplemental Security Income (SSI), Foster Care, or if they are homeless.

The Application Process: Please complete the attached application and return to our offices at 2009 Tenth Street in Berkeley. Please make sure you answer every question on the waitlist application. Missing information may cause the application to be rejected. Once the application is complete and accepted, you will receive a letter in 2-3 weeks regarding your eligibility and waitlist status.

Required Documents: Please attach copies of the following documents to the application for verification of eligibility. Incomplete applications will not be accepted.

<input type="checkbox"/> Proof of Eligibility: Proof of income is required for each adult in the household. One month's worth of current (within 30 days) pay stubs, employment verification from current employer, or self-declaration of income Examples of other countable income: - Unemployment Benefits, disability income or worker's compensation - Notice of Action for CalWorks or printout -Statement of Receipt of SSI -Foster Assistance -College/university scholarships, grants and fellowships	<input type="checkbox"/> Proof of other statuses as indicated on your application - -Proof of Pregnancy from Doctor for Pregnant Women with due date -Proof of diagnosed disability - Current IEP/IFSP, letter from doctor – if applicable -Proof of student status - Student ID, class schedule, etc -Documentation of homelessness, including a letter from a social worker, contract with a shelter or other documentation of unstable housing
<input type="checkbox"/> Proof of Age - Birth Certificate, Foster Placement or other document that shows a relationship between parent and child for every child in the home that is under 18 years of age	<input type="checkbox"/> Child's Immunization Record and TB Clearance, if available
<input type="checkbox"/> Proof of Single Parent Status – Custody Agreements, Proof of child support	<input type="checkbox"/> Copy of Medical Card
<input type="checkbox"/> Proof of Residency (Required for Berkeley, Albany and Emeryville Residents) - Utility bills, Bank Statement, Driver's License or Rental Agreement	

Full-Day Services

Enrollment in full-day services is also available. In order to qualify for full-day services, a family must demonstrate a need for child care by either working or attending school/training, or having a diagnosed disability. Verification of need, family size and income must be provided. The agency will then determine your eligibility for full-day services.
